Submission details

The Editorial Board of “Public Governance” accepts only original academic articles in English, which have not been previously published in any other periodicals or books.

All articles **should be devoted to the decentralization reform in Ukraine or broader in Central and Eastern Europe** and be correlated with the journal's mission.

Submitted manuscripts should not exceed the recommended size in accordance with the established rules: 30 000 – 40 000 characters, including abstract, keywords, tables, figures, references, etc. Authors can find submission instructions, including the guidelines for authors, and all other relevant information on the journal website:
