Public Policy Design – Postgraduate studies

Aim of Postgraduate Studies:

Postgraduate Studies in English extended with "policy labs", where students will learn how to design and implement public policies (at the level of central, regional and local authorities) and learn about Polish institutional solutions in specific areas.

Study Program:

- Determinants of Public Policy Politics and Law
- Determinants of Public Policy Economy and Technology
- Public Policy Frameworks and Instruments
- Public Policy Practical Applications
- Public Finance and Budgeting
- Grants and procurements toolbox
- Policy Evaluations Practical applications

Pass conditions:

- Tasks solved individually
- Active participation in classes
- Semester test checking acquired knowledge and skills

Implementation:

Duration: 2 semesters (180 h) Classes Saturday-Sunday or on weekdays. Graduates receive a certificate of completion of the Postgraduate or ECTS credits from Master's studies, as provided for by law.
